


Different Pages On Diro Pro

There are three different pages on Diro Pro: Single, Multi and Floating.

Single

The Single page can only have one component loaded, e.g. Watchlist or a Chart.

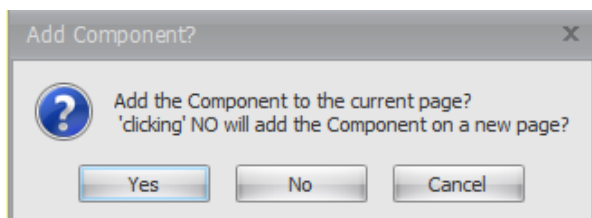

Multi

The Multi page can have multiple components loaded.



To add a new component to a multipage: Click on the instrument button and choose the component you want to add. There will be a message box that will give you an option to add the component to the current page or create a multipage on a new tab.



Floating

A floating page is like a Single page in that there can only be one component loaded. You can drag the floating page anywhere you want on your screen. To load a component onto a Floating page, right click on the page. A list of component will appear. Choose one from the list, that Floating page will use that component. To load a share onto the component open

the Instrument search panel, click and drag the Instrument onto the Floating page.
